SEEDING PROCEDURES:

AA-Division

1. All rules from the Federation rules book will apply.
2. Each school is allowed one team per relay event. You may list up to 8 swimmers per relay event.
3. There are no qualifying times. Please enter your swimmers and performances into each event. Remember you are only allowed 4 entries per individual event.
4. Each swimmer can participate in a total of 4 events with no more than 2 being individual events. Swimmers may also be listed in additional relay events as alternates.
5. The top 32 swimmers (4 heats) will compete in the 50 yd. and the 100 yd. Freestyle events.
6. The top 24 swimmers (3 heats) will compete in all other individual swimming events.
7. All seeding will be by time, **coaches are responsible to make sure the times provided are correct.**
8. Wyoming Valley Conference meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Cliff Jones. (See below)
9. Lackawanna League meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Rick Bresser. (See below)
10. Entry deadline is Thursday, February 20, 2020 at 9:00 AM.

AAA-Division

1. All rules from the Federation rules book will apply.
2. Each school is allowed one team per relay event. You may list up to 8 swimmers per relay event.
3. There are no qualifying times. Please enter your swimmers and performances into each event. Remember you are only allowed 4 entries per individual event.
4. Each swimmer can participate in a total of 4 events with no more than 2 being individual events. Swimmers may also be listed in additional relay events as alternates
5. There are now 7 boys' and 8 girls' schools (including Williamsport). We will seed the swimming events the same as the AA above.
6. All seeding will be by time, **coaches are responsible to make sure the times provided are correct.**
7. Meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Jones for Wyoming Valley Conference home meets. (See below)
8. Lackawanna League meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Rick Bresser. (See below)
9. Entry deadline is Thursday, February 20, 2020 at 9:00 AM.

VERIFYING TIMES: Coaches are required to provide proof of their swimmers individual and relay times if challenged by another coach. This proof, in the Wyoming Valley Conference will be the meet score sheets mailed weekly to Cliff Jones, Athletic Director, at Coughlin High School, 80 N. Washington St., Wilkes-Barre, PA 18701. If sheets were not received by Mr. Cliff Jones, the challenged time will be discarded.

In the Lackawanna League the proof will be the meet score sheets mailed weekly to Rick Bresser, Athletic Director at West Scranton High School, 1201 Luzerne St., Scranton, PA 18504. If Lackawanna sheets were not received by Mr. Rick Bresser, the challenged time will be discarded.

Remember, when a pool does not have AutomaticTiming; only the first place time can be used for seeding purposes. All times recorded by the automatic timer are to be recorded on the score sheet. All results are to be mailed to Mr. Jones and Mr. Bresser to arrive by Wednesday, February 20, 2019.

DIVING STANDARDS:

All diving programs will be completed online. Instructions are included.

All rules from the Federation rules book will apply. The additional requirements are:

1. For the 6 optional dives, girls must have a total degree of difficulty of at least 10.0; boys' degree of difficulty must be at least 10.5.
2. All dives listed on the diving entry must have been performed during the season and awarded a final average score of 5.0 or higher in any given meet.
3. Dives may be challenged. Coaches should have all of their diving score sheets (signed by referee) in their possession at the coaches' meeting prior to the start of the Diving Championships to answer challenges. If you cannot prove the dive was performed to an average of 5.0 or higher per judge, the dive must be changed.
4. Rule 9; Section 2, Article 2 now allows the Finalists in the Diving competition to be reseeded from lowest score to highest score after Semi-finals are complete. We will not be doing this.
