SEEDING PROCEDURES:

AA-Division

1. All rules from the Federation rules book will apply.
2. Each school is allowed one team per relay event. You may list up to 8 swimmers per relay event.
3. There are no qualifying times. Please enter your swimmers and performances into each event.
Remember you are only allowed 4 entries per individual event.
4. The top 18 swimmers (3 heats) will compete in all individual events.
5. All seeding will be by time, **coaches are responsible to make sure the times provided are correct.**
6. Wyoming Valley Conference meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Nick Gill. (See below)
7. Lackawanna League meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Scott Gower (See below)
8. Entry deadline is Thursday, February 25, 2021 at 9:00 AM.

AAA-Division

1. All rules from the Federation rules book will apply.
2. Each school is allowed one team per relay event. You may list up to 8 swimmers per relay event.
3. There are no qualifying times. Please enter your swimmers and performances into each event. Remember you are only allowed 4 entries per individual event.
4. We will seed the swimming events the same as the AA above.
5. All seeding will be by time, **coaches are responsible to make sure the times provided are correct.**
6. Meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Gill for Wyoming Valley Conference home meets. (See below)
7. Lackawanna League meet results will be verified by the Meet Score sheets sent to Mr. Scott Gower (See below)
8. Entry deadline is Thursday, February 25, 2021 at 9:00 AM.

VERIFYING TIMES: Coaches are required to provide proof of their swimmers individual and relay times if challenged by another coach. This proof, in the Wyoming Valley Conference will be the meet score sheets mailed weekly to Nick Gill, Athletic Director at Wyoming Valley West, 150 Wadham St., Plymouth, PA 18651. If sheets were not received by Mr. Gill, the challenged time will be discarded.

In the Lackawanna League the proof will be the meet score sheets mailed weekly to Scott Gower, Athletic Director at Scranton Prep HS, 1000 Wyoming Ave., Scranton, PA 18509. If Lackawanna sheets were not received by Mr. Gower, the challenged time will be discarded.

Remember, when a pool does not have AutomaticTiming; only the first place time can be used for seeding purposes. All times recorded by the automatic timer are to be recorded on the score sheet. All results are to be mailed to Mr. Gill and Mr. Gower to arrive by Wednesday, February 24, 2021.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR THIS YEAR: The winner of each individual and relay events will be an automatic qualifier to the State Championship Meet. The rest of the swimmers from all participating districts will be entered into a pool of swimmers for each event. The additional swimmers will be chosen from this list based on time. The maximum number of swimmers and relay teams will be maxed at 16 (2 heats).

For diving, only the champion will qualify and compete in the State Championship Meet.

DIVING STANDARDS:

All diving programs will be completed online. Instructions are included.

All rules from the Federation rules book will apply. The additional requirements are:

1. For the 6 optional dives, girls must have a total degree of difficulty of at least 10.0; boys' degree of difficulty must be at least 10.5.
2. All dives listed on the diving entry must have been performed during the season and awarded a final average score of 5.0 or higher in any given meet.
3. Dives may be challenged. Coaches should have all of their diving score sheets (signed by referee) in their possession at the coaches' meeting prior to the start of the Diving Championships to answer challenges. If you cannot prove the dive was performed to an average of 5.0 or higher per judge, the dive must be changed.
