Schools may submit two singles entrants and two doubles teams. The District singles representative(s) in state competition may not participate in the doubles competition.

Schools who do not sponsor a tennis team may participate in the singles competition only. The fields (AA and AAA) for the singles tournament will include two entrants from each member school plus at-large bids from schools that submit entrants but do not sponsor a team. We must also include Williamsport from District IV in the AAA division because this is a sub-regional. Packets were sent out to every school in District II so we must see who responds before the pairings can be completed. The fields may also be increased with the addition of at-large individuals to the fields.

In order to establish singles and doubles draw with provisions for proper seeds, return enclosed seeding information form with the names, position on the team if available, current record, names of opponents, scores of matches, 2018 Summer Tournament Results of your entries by Friday, **October 9th**. All coaches are invited to a seeding meeting and formation of singles draw to be held at 7 P.M. on Wednesday, **October 14th** at Dunmore High School. Doubles seeding and draw to be finalized with the completion of the singles' tournament.

By Friday, **October 9th** all entry fees (\$8.00 for each participant) must be sent with registration form to the tournament co-chair.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. If no seeding sheet is submitted for either singles or doubles, no seed will be given.
2. Teams and team members are to report immediately to the court assigned.
3. **Coaches are needed to clean the courts at Kirby Park. Please report at 8:00 A.M. and bring a broom or leaf blower so that the matches can begin promptly at 9:00 A.M.**
4. All participants must be accompanied by a school representative or appointed coach.
5. After participants are eliminated from the tournament, they are expected to return to their respective schools.
6. Every participant is to be dressed in their proper school uniform. According to the P.I.A.A. all contestants are required to wear the appropriate tennis attire (i.e. school issued tennis shirt and shorts or skirt). No exceptions are permitted. T-shirts without school name/nickname, altered apparel, jeans and advertisements (other than one visible logo/trademark not exceeding 2 ¼ square inches and 2 ¼ inches in any dimension on cap, headband, visor, school issued tennis shirt, and shorts or skirt; and/or a school's name/nickname will not be permitted. The use of tape for the purpose of covering a logo that does not meet the aforementioned specifications will not be permitted. The school's name/nickname and/or the school's logo are permitted on the front and/or back of the school issued tennis shirt. Shoes with soles that leave discolored markings on the competition surface are prohibited.
7. **In case of inclement weather: All postponement information will appear on the District II website immediately at www.piaad2.org – information should be posted no later than 6 a.m.**

PIAA DISTRICT II TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS
TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Schools may submit two singles entrants and two doubles teams. Schools, which do not sponsor a tennis team, may participate in the singles tournament only. The District singles representative(s) in the State Tournament may not participate in the doubles event.
2. Each participant is to bring a new can of approved USTA tennis balls.
3. Players are required to begin play after a ten (10) minute warm up period.
4. All matches will consist of best of three (3) sets. Players may leave the court area for five (5) minutes if they split sets.
5. A twelve (12) point tiebreaker will be used if set scores go to six-all in games.
6. There will be no ad until the semifinal and final matches. Ad will be used in all matches in which a state berth will be at stake.
7. A 'chair' may be used in the semifinals and finals. **Players will continue to call their match. The 'chair' will only serve to break disputes.**
8. Contestants should check with the Tournament Directors for the scheduled starting time of their matches. Any player failing to report for a match on time may be eliminated from the tournament.
9. All players are expected to call their matches without incident. If a problem develops, a request for help should be made to the tournament directors by the contestants.
10. Although this tournament is not sponsored by the USTA, USTA rules will govern all play. During the PIAA tennis championships, the USTA point penalty system will be followed. The purpose of this system is to deter, not punish, unsportsmanlike conduct.... including tardiness.

USTA POINT PENALTY SYSTEM
(PIAA MODIFIED)

DELAY OF GAME

For violations of delay of game:

- (a) At change over or other times, stalling, prolonging argument over decision, injury time out.
- (b) Failure to start play after expiration of established warm up period of ten (10) minutes.

PENALTY: first offense, warning; second offense, one point; third offense, one game; fourth offense, default.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT

- (a) Profane or obscene language or gestures, when not directed at a person or persons: first offense, warning; second offense, one point; third offense, one game; fourth offense, default.

When directed at an official, opponent, or spectator(s):

First offense, one point; second offense, one game; third offense, default

- (b) Abuse of racket, balls, equipment: such as hitting or kicking ball out of court; first offense, warning; second offense, one point; third offense, one game; fourth offense, default.
- (c) Major unsportsmanlike acts, such as hitting a ball at or near an official, ball boy, linesman, or spectator(s), or intentional racquet dropping to disconcert an opponent: first offense, two points; second offense, one game; third offense, default.

TARDINESS

A player will be penalized one game for each five minutes or fraction thereof, of tardiness from the time the match is called and both court and opponent are ready; this does not rule out liability to outright default of fifteen (15) minutes of unexcused lateness beyond the set deadline.

In the process of submitting names and seeding sheets for doubles, please do so with the intent that your player will not win the singles tournament. That way, accurate seeds can be given. If your player does win the singles tournament, only then will we make an adjustment to your doubles team.

INFORMATION ON TEAM TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The team tournament will begin on **Friday, October 9th (if necessary); and, Tuesday, October 13th (quarterfinals)** with all of those matches at the higher seed. **In accordance with the District II move to the Power Rating System for team playoff championships, the TOP 8 power ranked teams in each classification will participate in the team tournament regardless of league affiliation. Champions will not receive special seeding privileges and will be ranked ONLY based on their power rating. In addition, any other team in a classification that finishes with EITHER a .500 league winning percentage or a .500 overall winning percentage and finishes outside of the top 8 in power rating will also qualify for the tournament – so there is a potential for more than 8 teams to qualify in a bracket.**

Both semifinals and finals will be held at Kirby Park on Thursday, **October 15th**. The AAA Semifinals will begin at 11 A. M., the AA Semifinals at 12:30 P.M. The AAA Finals will begin immediately following the AA Semifinals and the AA Finals will begin 45 minutes after the completion of the AA Semifinals. When the pairings and sites have been determined, your athletic director will be notified if your team has qualified.

District II will supply the match balls for the semifinals and finals. The host team will supply the match balls for the quarterfinals. You can follow the tennis results and standings on the District II webpage (www.piaad2.org) throughout the season.

COVID RESTRICTIONS

- SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT THIS YEAR'S TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS. **That may change based on PA Department of Health Guidelines. I will keep you informed as we move closer to the events.** Coaches and non-participating players will also be required to be masked at all times. All non-participating individuals will be required to social distance.
- Players are asked to social distance on the court. Please maintain six feet separation with all equipment and during all changeovers.
- If competition is held indoor only participation players and coaches will be allowed in the facility and must be masked at all times while not in actual competition on the courts. **NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED INDOOR. NO NON-PARTICIPATING ATHLETES WILL BE ALLOWED INDOOR.**
