**SUBJECT: 2020 Girls' Volleyball District Championships**

## **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:**

**A and AAAA:** There are 4 A schools and 4 AAAA schools in District II. All teams in both classifications will qualify for the District Tournament. Seeding will be done using the power rating system.

**AAA:** There are 10 District II teams and 2 teams from District IV (Shamokin & Athens). Of the 12 teams forming the sub-region, the top eight teams will qualify for the AAA tournament as well as any other team that finishes with a .500 record or above. Seeding will be determined by the power rating system.

**AA:** There are 7 teams from District II in this classification. All teams will qualify. Seeding will be done using the power rating system.

**All matches need to be completed by Saturday, October 24 to count in the power ratings.**

**COVID CHANGES:** All matches will be held at the highest seed. All matches will be single matches—no double headers. All matches will begin at 5:00. There will be no spectators. Following the Governor's indoor crowd restrictions, only 25 people will be allowed in the gym. That would include 9 players & 1 coach per team, 2 officials and 3 table workers. There will be no line judges. The home team is responsible to pay your table workers and trainer to be on site & available. District II will pay the officials and game manager.

Final—Nov. 4

All matches will be the best of five rally scoring. The first four sets will be 25 point sets with no caps. If the fifth set is necessary, it will be a 15 point set with no cap.

The District II Volleyball Committee reserves the right to adjust the playing dates as necessary.

After the final match is held in each there will be **no award ceremony**. The District II plaque will be presented to the captains, but both the silver and gold medals will be given to the school's Athletic Director/Principal to be distributed to the team.

If any team chooses to opt out of the tournament, they must contact Frank Majikes or Maureen Williams by Tuesday, October 20.

The visiting team should bring their own warm-up balls. The home team will provide the 3 "table" balls.
