

## SUB-REGIONAL FORMATS FOR DISTRICT 2

2022-2024

### FALL SPORTS

#### Football

**A (5 Schools) – Jenkintown, Renaissance Academy, and Morrisville (1) with Old Forge and Lackawanna Trail (2)**

Each District will determine their District Champion in Week 11 – those two champions will meet in Week 12.

**AAAAAA (13 Schools) – Williamsport (4) and Easton, Emmaus, Freedom, Liberty, Dieruff, Nazareth, Northampton, Parkland, Stroudsburg and William Allen (11) with Hazleton Area and Wilkes-Barre Area (2)**

Top 8 teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament regardless of District. Three weekend tournament with quarterfinals, semifinals and finals – seeding by power rating system.

If one D2 team qualifies, they will be the D2 Champion.

If both D2 teams qualify and they play each other in the tournament, that game will also serve as the District II Championship game. If both D2 teams qualify and they do not play each other in the tournament, the team that advances the farthest will be the D2 Champion. If both D2 teams qualify and do not play each other and they both advance to the same round the D2 team with the highest power ranking will be the D2 Champion.

If no D2 teams qualify, the D2 teams will play each other on the first playoff weekend for the D2 Championship.

Top 8 teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament regardless of District as well as any other team that finishes with a .500 record or above. Seeding will be determined by power rating system.

**AAAA Girls Volleyball (5 Schools) – Williamsport (4) with Delaware Valley, Hazleton Area, Scranton, Wilkes-Barre Area, and Wyoming Valley West (2)**

All 5 teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament regardless of District. Seeding will be determined by power rating system.

### **Field Hockey**

**AA Field Hockey (8 Schools) – Shikellamy and Selinsgrove (4) with Abington Heights, Berwick, Crestwood, Dallas, Pittston Area, and Wallenpaupack (2)**

All 8 teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament regardless of District. Seeding will be determined by power rating system.

All teams will qualify for the Sub-regional Championship. Semifinals and Finals seeded by power rating system.

All teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament. Seeding by power rating system.

### **Lacrosse**

**AAA Boys Lacrosse (10 Schools)** – Easton, Emmaus, Freedom, Liberty, Nazareth, Northampton, Parkland, and Pleasant Valley (11) with Delaware Valley and Wilkes-Barre Area (2)

Top 6 teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament regardless of District as well as any other team that finishes with a .500 or above record. Seeding will be determined by power rating system.

**AAA Girls Lacrosse (11 Schools)** –Parkland, Emmaus, Easton, Liberty, Freedom, Northampton, Nazareth and Pleasant Valley (11) with Hazleton Area, Delaware Valley, and Wilkes-Barre Area (2)

Play-in game for one state qualifier spot. District 2 Champion will play District 11 Champion. Championship game will be played in District 11 (2023) and in District 2 (2024).

## **Softball**

**A Softball (7 Schools) – Greenwood and Halifax (3) with Forest City, MMI, Mt. View, Old Forge, and Susquehanna (2)**

**AAAAAA Softball (5 Schools) – Williamsport (4) with Hazleton Area, Delaware Valley, Wilkes-Barre Area and Wyoming Valley West (2)**

All teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament. Seeding by power rating system.

**AAAAA Softball (7 Schools) – Shikellamy (4) with Abington Heights, Crestwood, Pittston Area, Scranton, Wallenpupack and West Scranton (2)**

All teams will qualify for the Sub-regional tournament. Seeding by power rating system.

### **DISTRICT II CHAMPIONS IN SUBREGIONAL TOURNAMENTS**

- If a District II team wins a subregional tournament they will also be the District II Champion as well.
- If a non-District II team wins a subregional tournament, the highest ranked District II team (utilizing the power rankings) going into that tournament will be the District II Champion unless.....
- That subregional advances three teams to the PIAA tournament and the Championship game of the subregional is between two non-District II teams and the Third Place (state qualifier) game is between the two District II teams that lost in the semifinals. The third place game will then be for the District II Championship and the right to enter the PIAA State Championships in that sport, OR
- In the course of that subregional tournament (with only one qualifier) the District II team that appears in the final has previously defeated the highest seeded District II team entering the tournament on the way to the subregional championship game.
