## Registration:

## **Transportation:**

Please ask your bus/van drivers to drop off your student-athletes on the east side of the building (Athletics). There is plenty of parking for all the buses and vans associated with the competition. All competitors enter through the east side doors and proceed to the school cafeteria.

## **Staging Information:**

Belongings may be left in the back section of our cafeteria where tables will be marked for each school. Stretching and warm ups can be done one half hour before your performance in our Wrestling Room and also in our auxiliary gym.

### Admission:

**\$6.00-dollar admission fee.** Tickets must be obtained through Hometown tickets. Please visit the PIAA District II Web Site for details. All children 5 and under are free and Adults 65 and older (with prove of age) are free.

### **General Procedures:**

We ask that when teams are not participating, they either sit in the stands or in a section of extra chairs on the floor. No parents will be permitted onto the competition surface or in the cafeteria areas.

### Awards:

Awards will be presented at the end of the competition. The top three teams will receive medals and the top four will qualify for the State Championships in Johnstown, PA.
