



## 2026 District II Boys/Girls Lacrosse

District II will conduct AA and AAA Tournaments in both Boys and Girls Lacrosse.

**Boys: AA** There are 9 AA teams in District II. The top 8 qualifiers, plus any other team with an overall record of .500 or better, will qualify.

**AAA** This will be a subregional tournament with District XI. There are 10 AAA teams in District II and District XI. The top 4 teams will qualify for the subregional tournament regardless of District as well as any other team that finishes with an overall record of .500 or better.

**Girls AA** There are 12 AA teams in District II. The top 8 qualifiers, plus any other team with an overall record of .500 or better, will qualify.

**AAA** This will be a subregional tournament with District XI. There are 3 teams in District II and 8 teams in District XI. Each District will conduct their own District Championship tournament and then the two District Champions will meet to determine the subregional entry into the PIAA State AAA Girls Lacrosse Championships. This year that subregional championship contest will be held in District XI.

Seeding for all of the tournaments will be based on the District II Power Rating System. Daily updated standings can be found on the District webpage at [www.piaad2.org](http://www.piaad2.org) under the Power Rating Story on the front page. Just click on "District Power Rating Fan Page" and then either Boys or Girls Lacrosse in order to locate those standings.

All games will be played at the higher seeded team – **including the championship games.**

The home team will be responsible for all expenses for games played on their home field including the referee fees, except for the final. The home team is responsible for providing a trainer for their home games. (Officials' fees will be \$7.00 higher than the league rate).

The home teams should supply lacrosse balls for the game.

The District will supply each team with 24 medals for the championship team and the runner-up. Please contact Tim Hopkins, District Lacrosse Chairperson, if you need additional medals.

There is NO ADMISSION COST until the finals.

The COST OF ADMISSION for the finals will be \$6 for both students and adults.
