ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE IN TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS:

In order to compete in the D2 Track and Field Championships, the fastest **24** competitors (up to and including the 800m), will be eligible to compete. In all other running events, and all field events, the best **16** will be eligible to compete. All schools can enter one (1) team in all relay races. This pertains to each of the four divisions: AA Boys, AA Girls, AAA Boys, and AAA Girls.

METHOD OF SEEDING:

Times and/or distance...

1. Schools must submit ALL of their athletes electronically using the “MileSplit” Online Meet Registration System website. Failure to use the software may prohibit athletes from competing.
2. Only times and distances achieved in a meet after March 13, 2026 and officiated by a PIAA Official (Starter or referee) will qualify for the D2 Meet.
3. The metric system will be used for running events and English for field events. F.A.T times will be the standard. All hand-held times will be rounded to the nearest 1/10 of a second (0.01) and .24 seconds will be added. Distance in the shot put and all jumps shall be entered results to the nearest shorter quarter inch (1/4”). All distances in the discus and javelin should have results to the nearest lesser inch (1”).

- a. Example- an athlete runs a 11.67 with handheld. Now you have to round up to **11.7** then add .24 and the new official time for districts will be **11.94**.

CUT-OFF DATE FOR ENTRIES:

Friday, May 8, 2026 at 6 PM. Adjustments may be made based on inclement weather.

Entries window on “MileSplit”, which should include date and place of performance.

Entries Open – Monday, April 20, 2026 at 6 AM.

Entries Close – Friday, May 8 at 6 PM.

Qualifying Performance List – Saturday, May 9, 2026 at 8 AM will be posted and sent. There will be a “scratch window” from Saturday, May 9, 2026 at 8 AM through Sunday, May 10, 2026 at 8 a.m. The final performance list will be posted shortly thereafter.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL NOT BE A “SCRATCH MEETING” HELD PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- The weigh-in for all shots, discuses, and javelins will be from 1:30 to 2:30. It is the responsibility of each school to have their implements ready to weigh-in at the appropriate time.
- All pole vaulters must bring their completed certification form to the designated PIAA Official at the Pole Vault site.
- National Federation Rules will be used to run the meet.
- In the D2 qualifying meets to the PIAA Track and Field Championships, not more than three (3) contestants from a given school shall be allowed to enter an individual event. In a relay race, only one team per school may be entered.
- If schools are entering a relay team, the names of 4-8 prospective participants must be included, which can be changed up to and including the day of the race.

- All schools are limited to three (3) entries per event.
- All schools are responsible for correct and accurate registration of all athletes representing each school.
- **There will be no scratch meeting held prior to the meet.**
- No additional entries will be accepted after Friday, May 8, 2026 at 6 PM.
- All entry fee checks are to be handed in to John Coyle or Chad Vinansky on the day of the meet. (\$8.00 per entry, checks may be payable to PIAA D2).
- Practice times will be available on Friday, May 8, 2026 from 4 PM – 8 PM and on Saturday May 9, 2026 from 8 AM – 12 PM.
- Tickets for the Track and Field Championships will be available to purchase through HomeTown Ticketing. More information regarding the purchase of tickets will be forthcoming.

Additional Information

Field Entry and Exit

- Participating athletes and coaches shall enter/exit the facility only through the entrance located near the javelin.

Field Access Requirements

- No coach, spectator, or unauthorized individual shall be permitted on the field without a valid PIAA District II credential.
- Field access requirements will be enforced in the same manner as PIAA District II Basketball events held in arena settings.

Team Credentials

- Each school will be issued four field passes. These passes will allow access to the pole vault area, the official scoring tent, and the jumping areas. No passes will be issued for general field events, as designated areas for coaches and spectators are already in place. The four passes will be divided between the boys' and girls' teams upon arrival.

Media Credentials

- Media outlets requesting track access must register with the PIAA District II Committee and receive approval from the Committee prior to May 1, 2026. **Limit of 2 badges per media outlet for the track.**
- Approved media personnel shall be issued an individual credential on the day of the event upon signing for the badge.

Enforcement

These procedures are intended to restrict field access to authorized personnel only and to ensure the safety and integrity of the competition for all student-athletes.
